INDIANAPOLIS – A 2013 Chevrolet Corvette ZR1 will lead the starting field of the 96th Indianapolis 500 to the green flag Sunday, May 27 at the Indianapolis Motor Speed-

With 638 horsepower, the Corvette ZR1 is the most powerful production car ever to pace the race.

This will be the 23rd time a Chevrolet has paced "The Greatest Spectacle in Racing" and the 11th time a Corvette is serving as the Pace Car. Both are event records. The 2013 model year will mark the 60th anniversary and the final year of production for the current generation Corvette.

'Corvette embodies pure performance, so the ZR1 is a perfect car to pace the most prestigious auto race in the world," said Jeff Belskus, Indianapolis Motor Speedway Corporation president and chief executive officer.



OnStar subscriber Marvin Sponaugle recently used his emergency connection to report an elderly driver who had slowed to an idle speed and was unconscious, slumped over the wheel. Sponaugle stopped to help and began administering medical assistance per the On-Star Advisor's instructions, which included clearing the man's airway.

"I gave the [Advisor] my [cell phone] number and he called me back so I could get closer to the man in need," said Sponaugle. "He gave me instructions to check if he was breathing and so [OnStar] should be in every vehicle because it could possibly help save more lives.'

UD Mercy's New EV Car Charging Station Is Open
