Cherokee, Charger and Challenger Brands Scoring Well with AutoPacific

AUBURN HILLS – The Jeep Grand Cherokee, Dodge Charger and Dodge Challenger are winners of AutoPacific's 2012 Ideal Vehicle Awards based on owners' ratings of their 2012 cars and trucks.

"Winning awards for Jeep and Dodge vehicles based on customer feedback is very gratifying," said Doug Betts, Senior Vice President – Quality, Chrysler Group. "Recognition by the customers proves we take consumer input very seriously in all the vehicles we design and build at Chrysler."

Orion-Made Sonic Places Third On Kelley's Back-to-School List

DETROIT – The Chevrolet Sonic is one of KBB.com's top picks for its 10 Best Back-to-School Cars, placing third on the list. The Chevrolet Cruze was a top pick in 2011.

"Sporty design, vibrant colors, lots of space for friends and even that cool name make the Sonic hatchback and sedan attractive to younger drivers," said Jack R. Nerad, executive editorial director and executive market analyst for Kelley Blue Book's KBB.com.

"Their parents, meanwhile, will be keen on this subcompact's outward visibility, easy-to-drive manners, good fuel economy and eager (but not overwhelming) engines."

Starting at \$14,495, the Chevy Sonic is the only subcompact built in the United States. The Sonic comes with the most standard safety equipment in the subcompact class, including 10 air bags, and has earned an Insurance Institute for Highway Safety (IIHS) Top Safety Pick and a 5-star overall vehicle score for safety from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

The Sonic is produced at the GM Orion Assembly Center along with the Buick Verano. The plant was retooled recently to support the manufacture of these cars on behalf of GM.

Note that the Sonic's Ecotec

1.4L turbocharged engine delivers an EPA-estimated 40 mpg on the highway and 138 horsepower (103kW) – 18 horsepower (14KW) more than the Ford Fiesta.
