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## 2013 Dart GT Offers 'Style, Performance, Value'-Bigland

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A company spokesperson said when the Dart was relaunched last year it was announced that Dodge would be introducing an R/T model in the future.

"A couple of things happened," the spokesperson said. "Dodge had been out of the compact segment for seven years and it was decided (we needed) to get awareness to as large a segment of the buying public as possible."

The R/T is really a niche segment of the compact market. It is high performance and while Dodge wanted to offer a model that was "a little more premium," they didn't want that vehicle to be the R/T.

The reason is that the  $\ensuremath{\text{R/T}}$ would function more like a highperformance sports car. When you get to that level of performance, you can sacrifice some of the day-to-day driving comfort, Dodge officials say.

So Dodge decided to introduce the GT. It has more premium features and a more powerful engine than the two engines used in other Dart models. But while giving excellent performance for a compact, it's not at the R/T level.

The GT is for the person who wants a little bit sportier ride without sacrificing premium features and day-to-day driving comfort," the spokesperson said. "But the ride is not on the far extreme of the high-performance spectrum."

Dodge is still working on developing an R/T and drivers looking for that model could be seeing one in the future, the spokesperson said.

"The new Dart GT embodies the best attributes that compact car buyers are looking for, including outstanding style, performance, technology and value," said Reid Bigland, president and CEO, Dodge Brand.

"With 184 horsepower, 18-inch aluminum wheels, sport suspension, premium leather interior and several class-exclusive features, the Dart GT represents the sweet spot in the compact car market, offering mid-size roominess combined with premium amenities for only \$20,995 MSRP.'

The Dart GT model is the latest addition to the 2013 Dodge Dart lineup, which currently includes the Dart SE, SXT, Rallye, Aero and Limited models. Dodge continues to investigate a highperformance R/T model.

Building off the Dart Limited, the GT adds such features as:

184 horsepower 2.4-liter Tigershark with MultiAir 2 with sixspeed manual or available sixspeed PowerTech automatic AutoStick; 18-inch aluminum wheels; and a sport suspension with frequency-sensing damping shocks.

Ford Motor Co. plans to hire 2.200 salaried workers in the U.S. this year - the largest increase in new salaried workers in more than a decade – to support the continued aggressive pace of new Ford product introductions.

"As we expand our product lineup of fuel-efficient vehicles. we need more people in critical areas - such as in a range of engineering activities, vehicle production, computer software and other IT functions - to ensure we deliver the vehicles people want and value."

Ford's U.S. hiring also will help support the company's global product momentum.

The company also is stepping up its recruiting efforts to reach military veterans.

It was also announced in late December it is spending more than \$773 million on new equipment and capacity expansions across six manufacturing facilities in Southeast Michigan as it delivers on a commitment to invest \$6.2 billion in U.S. plants by 2015.

The investments in Michigan will create 2,350 new hourly jobs and allow the automaker to retain an additional 3,240 hourly jobs. The 2,350 new positions also are part of the 12,000 hourly jobs Ford is adding across the U.S. by 2015.

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
