## **MCC Partners with County** To Attract, Keep Businesses

Macomb Community College has long been a staple of education in Macomb County and was recently recognized by officials for their commitment to Macomb.

The college was named the 2013 Economic Development Partner of the Year by the Macomb County Department of Planning and Economic Development during the first-ever Macomb Awards held last month.

"It was a great surprise to all of us," said Holger Ekanger, director of workforce and continuing education, engineering and advanced technology at MCC. "I don't think anyone expected the award."

The college has partnered with the county for roughly 25 years now and helps attract and retain businesses to the area.

We all work together to make the county an attractive place to live and work," said Ekanger.

It's done through something called 4M, which includes the Macomb County Planning and Economic Development Department, Michigan Economic Development Corporation, Macomb/St. Clair Workforce Development Board (Michigan Works!) and MCC.

According to Ekanger, 4M was formed about two-and-a-half vears ago and is a smaller, solidified version of a former entity geared specifically to Macomb County.

"We know each other well," he said. "We look at the unique needs of employers and how to best meet those needs.'

One way they achieve this is through development programs at the college. Some of the programs are designed specifically to address the certain needs of employers.

"What we have seen is that we've been working together very effectively," said Ekanger. "The college plays a key role by helping develop programs to address employers' needs.'

Ekanger says that 4M is constantly asking how to assist in the attraction and retention of businesses and how to connect that to education and training.

"We're able to build programs that employees need," he said. "MCC is a resource to help meet employers' needs and ensure the skill sets of employees meet the needs of the employers. It's not only education and training.'

The size of the company doesn't matter – small, medium, large the goal is to help companies in Macomb County be successful.

"We know what each partner brings to the table so we're really able to steer companies in the right direction and meet their individual needs," said Ekanger.

According to a press release by the Macomb County Planning and Economic Development Department, the college's "excellent entrepreneurial training programs have been instrumental in helping businesses establish a strong foundation.'
